

Step up orientation with better communication!

Orientation is the time to show students how things work on your campus. Use Webex with your orientation groups, just like they will in their classes and clubs.

Add them to a Space, or email their institution address, to download Webex.



Give it a try!

1. Set up one “announcement only” Space for everyone in the same orientation week. Post the schedule, all important updates and meeting times/places here.
2. Have the dean or a university leader post a welcome message or video to everyone.
3. Have each orientation leader set up a Space with their orientation group. Ask the students to introduce themselves, where they’re from, and what they like to do.
4. Show students how they can join public club or topic Spaces, to learn about what’s happening on campus.
5. Have a scavenger hunt around campus! Put students in pairs and have them roam campus, posting pictures to their orientation group, of places they found, and a fact about it.
6. Ask everyone to upload a profile picture of themselves on campus.
7. Not everyone can be there? Broadcast and record the crucial sessions to share later.
8. Let students know they can ‘keep the Space alive’ and ask questions or stay connected even after orientation.
