 Multiple sites could have their own instances.
- Configure the solution to fit your needs (Persistent Meetings, Blast Dial Meetings, Personal Meetings).
- No user action/download is required.
- Meeting Survivability solution is always on.
 Whenever an event occurs, you can make the switch to the survivable solution.
- Seamlessly join meeting via a bowser. Network connection to the site/data center is required.
