A modern workplace in a historic city setting

Nestled within the confines of historic Finsbury Circus, across from the largest public open space within London's city boundaries, sits Cisco's newest Collaboration Center. Keeping in line with Cisco's recent workplace projects in New York City, Paris, Atlanta, Milan, and Shanghai, Cisco's London City office combines innovative technology, cutting-edge space design, and contemporary furnishings to create a work environment that is ready to "earn the commute" of employees.

As with Cisco's other new workplaces, Cisco's London City office is designed to be one of the most connected, sustainable, and collaborative work environments ever created. Phase 1 – the build-out of a 2,000 m² (~22,000 ft²) new space on Level 6 – doubles Cisco's presence in this location. This area is specifically designed for employees, customers, and partners to collaborate, learn, and socialize. Phase 2, expected to be complete in late 2025, will modernize the existing 1,850 m² (~20,000 ft²) of employee-focused space on Level 7 that Cisco has occupied since 2009.

Built on a Power over Ethernet (PoE) foundation, 100% of the lighting and a portion of the shading are low-voltage, powered by the Cisco network, contributing to Cisco's sustainability goals for the location (LEED Gold). In addition, 100% of the sit-stand desks are powered over PoE as well, supporting our health and wellness objectives (WELL Platinum). When combined with other technology elements — such as Cisco Collaboration Devices, cloud-managed Cisco Catalyst WiFi Access Points, Meraki Cameras and Sensors, and Cisco Spaces, all connected by the Cisco network — the London City office is the next step in Cisco's journey to digitize its real estate portfolio.


The office also includes wellness spaces, such as sensory escape rooms, to support employee well-being. Cisco Spaces technology enables individuals to explore the office virtually before visiting.




Building System Integration

Leveraging the open APIs available from the smart building systems and the UI Extension feature within the Cisco collaboration devices, custom buttons have been installed on the Cisco Board Pros, Cisco Desk/Desk Pros, and the Cisco Room Navigator to control lights and shades in the collaboration spaces.

The integrations leverage the openness of the smart building APIs and the Cisco collaboration devices, and do not require using any third-party control systems (Crestron, AMX, etc.). They are now available on GitHub for download and use.


Providing areas for people to do focus work or passively participate in a remote meeting is critical in the hybrid work environment, and the hot desk is the ideal space for these activities.

In the London City office, 100% of the desks are low voltage and powered by the Cisco network. This includes powering the height-adjustable desk motor, task light, USB-C worktop power module for laptop and mobile device charging, as well as the Cisco Desk device.

With a simple scan of the QR code, employees can sign in and book the desk for a few hours or for the rest of the day. Hot desking turns the Webex Desk into the employee's personal meeting device, enabling meeting notifications, One Button to Push (OBTP) to join a meeting, and whiteboarding. The device can also be used as a secondary display. With both USB and Bluetooth® audio output connectivity, employees can easily connect their personal headsets or earbuds so they don't disturb others around them. The Cisco Desk device can also be used as a secondary monitor.




Brainstorming Huddle Room Room Layout - Counter Height












with Multi-camera Cinematic Meetings: Overview

This large Collaboration Room is designed to deliver the most inclusive and engaging virtual meeting experience. This space leverages a new capability from Cisco called Cinematic Meetings to ensure remote participants get the best view of any meeting at any time.

This multi-camera room uses two (2) additional Cisco PTZ 4K cameras that are mounted on either side of the table. They work together with the main Room Kit EQX camera at the front of the room and with the Cisco Microphones in the room. The Al Director in the Room Kit EQX automatically analyzes room activity, recognizing the active speakers and tracking where people are facing. It then automatically chooses the best camera angles, zooms, and crops the images appropriately. With Cinematic Meetings, remote participants can enjoy the best view of the participants in the room, see their facial expressions, and feel more included – even when the discussion is happening between people facing across the table.
